EU Directive on broadband cost reduction: missed opportunity?

The FTTH Council Europe welcomes the recent agreement on the EU Directive on broadband cost reduction. However, we are disappointed that the proposed directive has missed an opportunity to require that multi-dwelling units are equipped with future-proof fibre cabling. The Council hopes that European Governments will go beyond the Directives and choose a future-looking approach for in-building cabling solutions.
