

Gimme Fibre Day 2016 – Twitter Selfie Contest

Terms and Conditions:

1. The organiser of this contest is the FTTH Council Europe ASBL.
2. The contest begins on 4 November 2016 at 14:00 Central European Time (CET) and ends on 18 November 2016 at 14:00 CET.
3. To be considered a contestant, the participant's photo must be published on Twitter using the hashtag #iwantfibre. Each participant may only submit one photo. Participants submitting multiple photos will be excluded from the contest.
4. All posts made on this site and in connection with the contest must comply with Twitter rules and must not contain or imply any libellous, sexist or racist remarks or images. Any post containing such content will be removed without exception.
5. All participants must publish their photo before 18 November 2016 at 14:00 CET. In the photo, the participant must be holding a sign with "I want Fibre!" written in his/her language. The text on the sign of the winner will be validated by the FTTH Council Europe for accuracy. The participant whose picture earns the highest number of Twitter likes on the participant post by the end of the contest period will win the contest. In case of a tie (with two or more participants earning the highest number of likes), the organiser will choose the winner.
6. The FTTH Council Europe has the right to disqualify a participant if the FTTH Council Europe judges that the participant has cheated.
7. The winner's name will be announced and the photo posted on the FTTH Council Europe Twitter: @FTTHCouncilEU. The winner will be notified by private message on his/her Twitter account or through the application system, so that he/she can provide a postal address to which the organiser can send the prize. The winner wins a "fan package" I want Fibre.
8. If the winner has not responded to our message within four weeks (28 days) of being notified, another winner will be selected and the prize will go to that winner instead.
9. The awarded prize cannot be exchanged or redeemed for cash.
